"The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience (forbearance), kindness, generosity (goodness), faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against such things." (Galatians 5:22-23)

I thought for my newsletter article for August & September, I would share some of my notes on "The Fruit of The Spirit" from my Sermon on June 29, 2025. (Quotations are from Rev. Tyler Sit's book <u>Staying Awake The Gospel for Changemakers</u>)

Love - Tyler states "the word for 'love' here is agape. Agape is more about an unconditional love for all that is."

Joy - "Joy doesn't mean pasting on a smile whenever you go to church, and it doesn't mean anesthetizing yourself to the world's suffering. It's more like, at the end of the day, the Gospel becomes the song that gets you dancing no matter what."

Peace - Here is an interesting way to think of peace from Tyler: "Peace is 'I messed up, and I can apologize for it without forgetting my belovedness.' Peace is 'My worth is not up for debate, and neither is yours.'" I am a special gift of God and you are a special gift of God! Period!

Patience or Forbearance - "means that you're ready to show up even after you've been thrown to the ground again and again."

Kindness - "Kindness is not conflict avoidance; it's the choice to use your words and actions in a way that leaves people more bonded and healthier, whether you are in conflict or not."

Generosity or Goodness - "Our nation is currently in a crisis of goodness, because through social media we are discovering exactly how crooked even our most valiant heroes have been. This tends to lead to all-or-nothing thinking that seems to imply that if someone ever committed any sort of wrong, they can be permanently discounted from the discourse. If this were true, we wouldn't need Jesus at all. The good would be perfect, and the bad would be irredeemably condemned. Goodness is the belief that God's goodness is greater than our biggest mistake and that we can slowly learn to embody more and more of that goodness to repair the people and world that we harmed."

Faithfulness - The practices for me of Christianity from a Wesleyan perspective leads to as Tyler states "discernment and clarity." If you have a devotional life, a worship life, a compassionate service life, and a seeking of God's justice life then you have a life of faith which is a "safety net that can catch you before you hit the floor of despair."

Gentleness - "Gentleness cleans away ego and demands attention to small actions that affect everything."

Self-Control - "Instead of self-control being some twisted game of whack-amole whose only goal is to stop yourself from acting out, self-control is more about needs being met... self control is a natural fruit of having your needs met. It takes a long time, but eventually the faith that life gives us is a way to have our needs met in God, in beloved community, and through the sheer pleasure of being a part of Creation. The impulses to self-medicate and act out of fear may never go away completely, but they're a lot less commanding when we rest in the goodness of God and the pleasure of God."

As we enter into August planning and September events of sharing Jesus through devotion, worship, compassionate service, and justice work; I pray that we exude the fruit of the spirit in our lives!
